ANNEXURE

SCHEME FOR GRANTING FINANCIAL AID TO MUSLIM GIRL STUDENTS STAYING IN HOSTELS

This Scheme aims at giving financial assistance to Muslim Girl Students staying in Government / Government recognized hostels for pursuing their study for UG and PG courses. This is one of the many initiatives that Government have taken to encourage education of Muslim girls.

I. Objective:- The objective of the scheme is to provide financial support to Muslim Girls hailing from poor families of Kerala who are forced to stay in hostels for pursuing their studies within Kerala. By providing financial assistance, the Government hope that more and more Muslim Girl Students from poor families could be encouraged to take up higher studies. This is in tune with the Government policy of inclusive development of higher education. Expansion of existing facilities with equitable sharing of opportunities for women and other marginalized sections of the society are prerequisites for such development.

II. Scope:- Financial aid, based on merit cum means will be awarded to Muslim girls who get admission in Government / Government aided institutions for studies leading to award of Graduate/ Post Graduate Degrees, Short Term Courses and who stayed in Government / Government approved hostels.

III. Amount of Financial Aid:- Boarding and lodging fees and other approved charges if any, payable by the student subject to a maximum of Rs.1000/- per month will be paid. The aid will continue till the completion of the course subject to maximum of Rs.10000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) per annum. No amount will be paid during the period of vacation if there are no regular classes / examination during vacation.

Note:- Recognized hostel means hostel recognized by the Government / Universities & Social Welfare Department for stay of students.

IV. Eligibility:- Muslim Girl Students staying in Government / approved hostels attached to / recognized by the institutions will be eligible to apply for Scholarship subject to the following conditions.

1. Muslim girl students admitted to Government / Government aided educational institutions alone are brought under the scheme.
2. Girl students admitted to short term courses run by Universities / Government Agencies are also eligible.
3. Should have passed the qualifying examination securing minimum 50% marks in aggregate.
4. The Scholarship is renewable. For renewal of the financial aid, the student should submit an application through the head of institution with the copies of Mark list.
5. Only students who are promoted to the next year of the course are eligible to apply for renewal of the financial aid for the next year. She should have obtained at least 50% marks in aggregate in the University examination.
6. If student could not appear for the University examination due to illness, financial aid will be distributed on production of a medical certificate issued by Government or medical officers of Government hospitals not below the rank of Assistant Surgeon, which should be recommended by the head of the institution. The student should appear for the examination in the next immediate chance and pass the same with at least 50% mark / C+ grade in 7 point scale.
7. Annual income of the parents from all source should be below Rs.2.5 Lakhs. Income and community certificate in original issued by revenue authority should be produced after primary selection but before final selection.
8. Certificate from the head of institution to the effect that the applicant is staying in hostel recognized by the institution is also to be produced with the application.

Application should be forwarded to Special Officer for scholarships, Office of the Director of Collegiate Education, Thiruvananthapuram through the Principal of the college / Head of Institution within one month of re-opening of colleges after summer vacation or within one month after closing of admission.

The amount of mess charges and room rent will be credited to the bank account of the student. The student should furnish the bank account details along with the application form.

V. Announcement of the Scheme:- The Special officer for Scholarship will invite applications through print media and the department website <http://www.collegiateedu.kerala.gov.in> every year soon after admission in colleges are over.

VI. Procedure for applying:- Application in the prescribed format is to be submitted by the student to the Principal of the college, who will scrutinize the application and send the same along with necessary certificates to the Special Officer for Scholarship, Directorate of Collegiate Education, Thiruvananthapuram, so as to reach him on or before the stipulated date and time. Monthly statement of mess charges, room rent etc. shall be submitted by the warden of the hostel to the Special Officer for Scholarship, who will pay the amount.

GUIDELINES FOR PROPOSED SCHOLARSHIP FOR MUSLIM GIRL STUDENTS

I. Objective:-

For promoting higher education among Muslim girl students, Government of Kerala have introduced a new scholarship from the academic year 2008-2009 - (Called) Muslim Girls Scholarship.

II. Scope:-

Muslim Girls students alone are eligible to apply for the scholarship. Scholarship under this scheme, will be awarded for pursuing studies in educational institutions in Kerala only. Scholarships will be awarded to Muslim girl students for studying various courses given below:-

III. The total number of scholarship will be 5000. Scholarship under various courses are as follows:-

- Degree - 3000
- Post Graduate Degree - 1000
- Professional - 1000

Subject wise allocation will be made based or changed on the number of application received.

IV. Amount of Scholarship:-

- For Under Graduate Courses Rs. 3,000/-per annum
- For Post Graduate Courses Rs. 4,000/- per annum
- Professional Rs. 5,000/- per annum

V. Coverage and Eligibility:-

Only those candidates who secure at least 50% marks in aggregate in the qualifying examination (ie., +2/degree) will be eligible to apply for scholarship. In the case of PG students marks obtained in Part III in the Degree examination (BA/B.Sc/B.Com/B.Pharma) alone will be considered. Students studying in Government/Aided/and Universities along will eligible for apply.

VI. Students who passed their qualifying examination during previous years are also eligible to apply for scholarship. But they will be ranked along with the students who passed their qualifying examination during the year of award.

VII. Mere eligibility does not confer on any candidate any right to secure scholarship

VIII. The awardee under this scheme should not receive any other government scholarship. In case any student in receipt any other government scholarship the same must be refunded before the benefit under this scheme is claimed.

IX. Annual income of the parents/guardians should not exceed Rs. 2.5 lakhs per year. Selected candidates should produce Income Certificate issued by competent Revenue authority in the prescribed form.

X. Mode of Selection:-**(a) Degree Courses:-**

Applications will be grouped in to the following groups based on subject of study - Arts & Commerce, Science, B.Pharm, BFA etc. Total number of scholarships in each group will be proportional to the number of applications received under each group.

(b) Post Graduate Courses:-

Applications will be grouped on the basis of marks obtained in main subject selected for degree course. The number of scholarships in a particular subject will be proportional to number of applications received in that subject.

XI. Duration and renewal:-

The scholarship can be renewed every year till the completion of the course, subjected to the following conditions:-

a) Only those candidates who were promoted to the next year of the course with at least 45% marks/C-grade in annual examination in case of yearly system and 45%marks/C grade in last two semesters put together in the case of semester system are eligible to apply for renewal.

b) Good conduct, character, regularity in attending classes and progress in studies are also conditions for renewal. Candidates should submit a certificate from the head of the institution in this regard. Scholarships of candidates who fail to submit this certificate will not be renewed. If a student fails to attend annual examination, due to illness her scholarship will be renewed for the next year only on the recommendation of the head of institution which should be made on the basis of a medical certificate (to be submitted by the student) obtained from a medical officer not below the rank of Assistant Surgeon of any Government Medical Institution.

XII. Payment of Scholarship:-

The Scholarship amount will be credited to the bank account of the students opened in State Bank of Travancore only.

XIII. Announcement:-

The Director of Collegiate Education/Special Officer for Scholarship will invite applications for scholarships through in newspapers/All India Radio every year. Notification to the effect will be published in the department website "www.collegiateedu.kerala.gov.in"

XIV. Application:- Application for scholarships under this scheme should comprise:-

- a) One copy of the prescribed application form duly filled.
- b) An affidavit in the plain paper by parent/guardian regarding annual income
- c) Copy of mark list of qualifying examination.
- d) Community Certificate (True Copy)

XV. Award of Scholarships:-


Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of income and merit. (The selection for the award of scholarship will be made taking in to account both merit and income of the candidate. 80% of the scholarship will be awarded considering income and 20% of the Scholarship under each category will be made according to merit.

List of selected students will be published in the office of the Special Officer for Scholarship/Director of Collegiate Education and department website. Selected candidates should produce the following documents within one month from the date of publication of selection list.

1. Income Certificate issued by Village Officer/Tahsildar.
2. Community Certificate issued by competent authority.
3. Attested copy of mark list by a Gazetted Officer of qualifying examination.

If any student fails to submit above documents within the time limit, selection will be cancelled and awarded to next eligible student.

Scholarship amount will be credited to bank account of the students after satisfactory submission of above documents only.



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
